Officials for Kids

Officials for Kids originated in Lansing in 2003 to support local fundraising efforts to construct a dedicated pediatric emergency room and waiting room at Sparrow Hospital. Since then, Officials for Kids has grown statewide to assist the Children's Miracle Network hospitals in Michigan on a variety of projects.

The Children's Miracle Network is a non-profit organization which raises funds for 174 children's hospitals across North America, including the four in Michigan: William Beaumont Hospital (Detroit), Helen DeVos Children's Hospital (Grand Rapids), Hurley Medical Center (Flint) and Sparrow Hospital (Lansing).

STATEWIDE OBJECTIVES

- Promote good health for Michigan youth
- Support outstanding health care for Michigan children
- Enhance the public image of sports officials in Michigan

STRATEGIES

Establish alliances between Michigan's four Children's Miracle Network Hospitals and local Approved Officials Associations to:

- Underwrite specific program, operational, and capital expenses of the CMN hospitals
- Promote and provide volunteer support for events which are consistent with the goals and objectives


Local Objectives

SPARROW REGIONAL CHILDREN'S HEALTH CENTER 

- **2006-2007** – Contribute to final construction phase of the Pediatric Emergency Room (\$3,000 one time)
- **Commencing 2008** – Underwrite entirely on an annual basis the "Family Care Kits" program in the Pediatric Emergency Room (\$100/kit)

HELEN DEVOS CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL

- **2007** – Underwrite entirely one Care Giver Work Station in the new Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (\$5,000 one time)
- **Commencing June 2007** – Underwrite entirely the "Visually Impaired Sports & Activity Day" (\$4,000 annually)
- **Commencing September 2008** – Underwrite entirely the cost of of the Kids' Burn Camp (\$15,000 annually)

WILLIAM BEAUMONT CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL 

- **2007** – Underwrite entirely the start-up cost for the "Referees for Reading" program (\$3,000 one time)
- **Commencing June 2007** – Underwrite entirely the "Referees for Reading" program (\$6,000 annually)

HURLEY MEDICAL CENTER 

- **2007** – Assist in underwriting Camp REACH, June 19-July 26, 2007 (\$3,000 one time)
- **Commencing June 2008** – Underwrite entirely Camp REACH (\$6,000 annually)
- **Commencing September 2009** – Underwrite entirely the cost of the Miracle Families Celebration (\$12,000 annually)
