Tournament Rules

MHSAA Tournament Rules will apply. Two (2) balls allowed in the bowling area with one ball allowed on the ball return for the five (5) bowlers at a time. All other bowling balls and bags are to be in the team's reserved ball section.

There will be a random draw to determine which teams bowl in the morning and who is in the afternoon. After the morning session, lanes will be oiled. Due to the new format, afternoon times are an estimate. Bowling will begin shortly after lanes are oiled following the morning session. Be sure to arrive early.

Cost

There is a \$10/person and \$60/team school fee. If you have a full boys and girls roster, your cost would be \$120. ***Please make the check payable to Spare Time Lanes.*** You may bring the check with you or pay by cash/credit card the day of the event. *****SCHOOLS MUST PAY ENTRY FEES BEFORE TEAMS ARE ALLOWED TO BOWL*****

Admission

Each bowler will be allotted **one** fan. Tickets are \$10 and must be purchased online (link and details to come). Fans for the afternoon session will not be allowed to attend the morning session. We will be clearing the facility of all fans following the morning session. Please note that if you need to go outside, **THERE WILL BE NO RE-ENTRY.**

Format

This year there are no Baker games. Each of the teams will roll four games. These games count toward team totals AND singles. The substitute (6th bowler) can be used as normal, but if a substitute is used, both the sub and the initial bowler are ineligible to qualify for the Singles Finals. Each of the five athletes would bowl four games for a total of 20 games for the Team total. Team ties will be broken by best team game of the series. Singles ties will be broken by best game of the series. The top TWO teams move on to MHSAA Finals. The top TEN Singles move on to MHSAA Finals

Between sessions

Following the morning session, everyone (fans, spectators and coaches) will be required to leave the facility for sanitizing. Nobody, including players and coaches, will be able to enter for the afternoon session until sanitizing is complete.

Masks

Masks must be worn at all times. If you need food, there will be a designated area for eating. This is the only place masks are allowed to be removed. If you are drinking, you can pull your mask down to take a drink, then it will need to immediately put back on.

Oil Pattern

Kegel "Allen" oil pattern will be used.

Practice Time

There will be fifteen (15) minutes of practice prior to the start.

Lane Assignments

Jason Friday, Cheboygan Athletic Director, will make the lane assignments by random draw prior to the tournament. Lane assignments will be posted at the doors and at the coaches meeting.

Practice prior to the tournament

Teams may contact **Spare Time Lanes** for practice times for open bowling. No practice is available on tournament days. A coach must monitor any practice.

Dress Code

Boys – Slacks are required. Jeans, cutoffs, shorts, sweatpants or warm-up pants will NOT be allowed. A collared shirt or a mock turtleneck shirt will be required. Absolutely, NO T-shirts will be allowed.

Girls – Slacks, shorts or skirts will be allowed. Skirts must reach the top of the knee and shorts shall be an appropriate length (no daisy dukes or holes). Jeans, cutoffs, sweatpants, warm-ups, **yoga/spandex pants will NOT be allowed**. A collared shirt or a mock turtleneck shirt will be required. Absolutely, NO T-shirts will be allowed.

Both – Neither boys or girls may wear hats, caps, or any other type of head gear. All cell phones, I-pods, CD players, MP3 players, DVD players, etc. may not be used by any competitor on the concourse during competition. Prior to competition, warm ups (jackets, sweatshirts, hoodies) must be removed and may not be used in competition.

If a violation of the MHSAA bowling dress code occurs, a warning will be given to the player and coach of the violating team. If at that time the dress code is not followed, a loss of bowling privileges and disqualification from the MHSAA Regionals or Finals will result. Coaches must also adhere to the MHSAA dress code regulations.

Coaching Restrictions

Two school coaches will be allowed in the bowlers' seating area during competition. Coaches are not allowed on the approaches. Coaching is allowed ONLY between frames. Coaches may NOT use IPADS for coaching in the bowlers' area.

Sportsmanship

Good sportsmanship for players and coaches is a must. Taunting, profanity, and intimidating conduct are not allowed. All MHSAA regulations regarding sportsmanship and disqualification penalties as stated in Regulation IV, Section 3 will be followed. Players will not be allowed on the approach to congratulate or celebrate the accomplishment of a fellow team member during bowling. Bowlers will not be allowed to enter an adjacent lane approach to celebrate or 'run-out' their delivery. Bowlers shall observe a one-lane courtesy for bowlers on adjacent lanes.

Alcohol and Tobacco

No alcohol or tobacco is allowed in the bowling area during any MHSAA event.
