PRACTICE:

Contact Lucky Jack's to make arrangements for any practice session(s) at the lanes. Warm-up on open lanes during the Tournament is prohibited.

SPECTATORS:

Unfortunately, due to MDHHS capacity restrictions, spectators will not be permitted.

LIVE STREAM:

Each participating school will be provided with the opportunity to provide **ONE** person for each gender (the same person or different) to live stream your team's games via the live stream platform of preference. If your school will be providing a live stream operator, his/her name must be provided on the included form. Glen Lake & Lucky Jack's will not be responsible for providing necessary technology to schools.

SCORE POSTING:

We will do our best to keep running scores after each game posted to the Glen Lake Athletics website. Viewers should visit glenlakeathletics.org and click on the Bowling Regionals headline on the home page. NOTE: All posted scores should be considered unofficial until final scores are verified by Coaches and Tournament Management.

MASKS/FACE COVERINGS:

Let's cover this challenging topic right from the start. Masks are expected to be worn **APPROPRIATELY (over the nose and down through the chin)** at all times by every student-athlete, coach, etc. Glen Lake has enforced this all winter long, and this MHSAA Regional event will be no exception. Despite what has occurred during regular season and league play this winter, appropriate masking will be required without exception. Masks are not to be altered from their medical & protective state.

Most importantly, masking the right way starts with the student-athletes themselves. In general, they are not permitted to allow their noses & mouths to be uncovered in school, thus, it should not be happening in sport. If the student-athletes are not adhering to the requirement, then it is the responsibility of that school's coach(es) to ensure enforcement of his/her team. If school administration is present, it should then be his/her issue to resolve. If individual teams are doing this the right way, and as expected, it should be a non-issue during this Regional Tournament. This should not be a Lucky Jack's nor Tournament Management issue to address...it should never get to that point. But, please understand ahead of time, that we will address it as we must.

REGIONAL BOWLING BALL LIMITS:

Because of this year's Regional format, space between pairs of lanes in most centers will be open. With the additional space, the restriction of bowling ball limits is being lifted and **increased to 4 balls per participant in the bowling center**. The paddock area will not be utilized.

COACH LIMITS:

To limit the number of people inside a house on Regional day, the number of coaches per team will be limited to **two coaches per gender per school**. Schools are expected to limit the number of coaches, if possible, and if you have one coach per team, that is the number you should have on-site. This is not the time to add coaches.

STAY SAFE:

Please talk with all of your bowlers and families about the importance of keeping everyone safe as we are in the final days of the regular season and headed into the tournament. Please communicate again with parents and bowlers to stay safe, communicate if anyone does not feel well for any reason so the right decisions can be made. Communication will be the key between schools, coaches, bowlers and families! We must work together to ensure that we are keeping everyone safe and that we are doing our part in helping the Bowlers advance from regular season play to the Regional and then on to the Final for the qualifiers!

ROSTERS/SCORING/LANE ASSIGNMENTS/ROTATION:

Teams will have five bowlers and one substitute.

Each of the five bowlers roll four games. These games count toward Team totals AND for Singles.

The substitute (Sixth bowler) can be used as normal, but if a substitute is used, both the sub and the initial bowlers are ineligible to qualify for the Singles Finals.

Bowlers will bowl together as a team during this Regional event.

Every other pair of lanes will be utilized with the open pair of lanes being used as the team storage area.

Teams will bowl cross-lane for two games on the assigned pair of lanes and then rotate to the LEFT one pair of lanes to bowl cross-lane the other two games. Example: Team A & Team B are assigned to Lanes 7 & 8. They will use the table area of lanes 5 & 6 as their equipment & belongings storage area. Team A & Team B bowl cross-lane for the first two games and then bowl cross-lane on Lanes 5 & 6. Therefore, lanes 5-8 will be the “block” of lanes that Team A & Team B occupy for all four of their games and their storage area for the day.

Lane assignments will be randomly drawn and sent to schools on Friday, March 12.

CHECKS SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO “LUCKY JACK’S”. PAYMENT MUST BE MADE, OR ARRANGEMENTS AGREED UPON, TO LUCKY JACK’S PRIOR TO PARTICIPATION. FEES WILL BE COLLECTED AT THE COACHES MEETING, OR THEY CAN BE MAILED TO GLEN LAKE HIGH SCHOOL, OR BROUGHT TO LUCKY JACK’S.

PLEASE DO NOT MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO GLEN LAKE and CREDIT CARDS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

MHSAA

GUIDELINES: The Kegel “Allen Pattern” lane condition will be used for all levels of the MHSAA Bowling Tournament.

ALL MHSAA uniform and conduct guidelines will be enforced (**NO Jeans, Yoga Pants, Spandex, Sweatpants, T-Shirts or Hats are allowed. Slacks are required for boys, collared shirts (or mock turtle necks) are required for boys & girls, and Coaches are expected to follow the same guidelines. Jewelry is permitted.**). Religious dress is permitted with prior approval from the MHSAA.

A maximum of two school coaches per gender will be permitted in the bowlers' area during competition. Coaches are not permitted on the approaches. Coaching is permitted only between frames.

Video recording devices such as iPads, tablets or smartphones may not be used by coaches during competition for coaching purposes, nor can coaches have such devices in the bowlers area.

Early warm-up not permitted on open lanes.

No outside food and/or beverage will be allowed into Lucky Jack's. Please review with student-athletes. A limited food menu will be available, and beverages may be purchased from Lucky Jack's vending machines. Please support Lucky Jack's for their continued willingness to host the Regional tournament!

It is house policy that outside footwear must be removed upon entrance into the bowling facility.

No cell phones in the bowling area!

No flash photography during competition. The awards presentation will allow for photos to be taken. All cameras should have their flash turned off.

Artificial noisemakers will not be permitted.

Cheer positively & respectfully for your team, as well as all other participants on a job well done.
