DATES & TIMES: Friday, March 19, **GIRLS Check-in at 7:00 AM, Coaches meeting** at 7:20 AM (Near Check in counter). Announcements and Anthem at 7:40. Warm up 15 minutes at 7:45. Each team will get 7 ½ minutes on each lane. **Bowling Begins promptly at 8 AM**

Friday, March 19, **BOYS Check-in at 11:00 AM, Coaches meeting** at 11:20 AM. Warmup 15 minutes at 11:45. **Bowling begins at 12:00PM**

ADMISSION: Ticket price will be \$10.00 per spectator.

- **TICKETS:** All tickets are being sold through GoFan. Regional ticket-buying links and codes will be emailed to participating schools on March 12.
- **CODES:** Each school will receive from GoFan 7 one-ticket access codes. These codes allow parents to have first access to tickets, but it also allows the host to limit ticket sales if necessary. Your host will communicate to you how many codes each school can distribute (if less than 7).
- **PUBLIC SALE:** There is no public sale of tickets. The only way buy a ticket is through an access code.

BOWLING AREA: Fairlanes has a raised concourse. Only participating bowlers and coaches who have badges will be allowed in the competition area. All others must stay in the spectator area. Each school will receive two badges for each girls' and each boys' team. No other coaches are to be in the bowling center.

LANE CONDITIONS - The Kegel "Allen Pattern" lane condition will be used for all levels of the MHSAA Tournament.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT & QUALIFIERS – The MHSAA Regional tournament format will be as follows:
Each of the five bowlers roll four games. These games count toward Team totals AND for Singles, so team members are bowling for both competitions at the same time. There are NO Bakers, and only FIVE bowlers will be attempting to qualify for the Singles Finals. The substitute (6th bowler) can be used as normal, but if a substitute is used both the sub and the initial bowler are ineligible to qualify for the Singles Finals. In this four-game format, each of the five athletes would bowl four games for a total of 20 games for the Team total.

TIEBREAKER PROCEDURES - REGIONAL – Team ties will be broken by best team game of the series. Singles ties will be broken by best game of the series.

UNIFORMS/DRESS CODE - Boys: Slacks are required. Jeans, cutoffs, shorts, sweatpants or warm-up pants will not be allowed. A collared shirt will be required. T-shirts will not be allowed. Mock-turtleneck shirts are allowed.

Girls: Slacks, shorts or skirts will be allowed. Skirts must reach the top of the knee and shorts shall be an appropriate length. Jeans, cutoffs, sweatpants, warm-up pants, or yoga/spandex pants will not be allowed. A collared shirt or mock turtleneck shirt will be required. T-shirts will not be allowed. Bowlers are not required to wear the same style of shirts or slacks, but similar uniforms are recommended. Jewelry is allowed.

Hats, caps or any other type of headgear is prohibited. Religious dress is allowed with prior approval from the MHSAA.

A single patch or embroidered area not to exceed 2 inches X 3 inches in size will be allowed to identify a sponsor. The logo or type must be approved by the MHSAA. It may appear once on either sleeve, or the left or right front breast-pocket area. School name, logo, school nickname or bowler name may also appear on the shirt. No offensive language of any sort is allowed on uniforms.

Coaches must also adhere to the MHSAA uniform/dress code regulations.

SPORTSMANSHIP/CONDUCT – Good sportsmanship for players and coaches is a must.

Taunting, profanity and intimidating conduct are not allowed. All MHSAA regulations regarding sportsmanship and disqualification penalties as stated in Regulation IV, Section 3

will be followed. Players will not be allowed on the approach to congratulate or celebrate the accomplishment of a fellow team member during bowling. Bowlers will not be allowed to enter an adjacent lane approach to celebrate or “run-out” their delivery. Bowlers shall observe traditional bowling courtesy for bowlers on adjacent lanes.

FOOD NO outside food or drink is to be brought into the bowling center. Fairlanes has numerous options available.

PADDOCK The party room will serve as the tournament paddock area Overnight storage of bowling balls is not available. The bowling center, MHSAA, or host school is **NOT RESPONSIBLE** for lost or stolen items. Do **NOT** leave valuables, i.e. phones, ipads, tablets, etc...in the paddock area.

In settling all disputes, the tournament manager will make all final decisions.
