Course	The course is on the campus of Linden High School and Linden Middle School. It is a rolling, two loop course on grass and trails.

Awards	The top team in each division will receive a trophy and the top 15 competitors earn a medal.
State Finals	The top three teams* will advance to the state finals. Any individuals in the top 15, whose team did not advance, qualify to compete at the state finals as well.
Results	A copy of the results will be available immediately following the awards ceremony. Full results will also be posted on athletic.net and michigancrosscountry.com that afternoon.
Team Tents	You may set up your team tent(s) in the fields surrounding the middle school.
Bus Parking	Buses should enter the complex from Silver Lake Road (high school entrance). They will drop-off athletes on the north side of the middle school and park in that lot. It is the closest lot with respect to the start/finish area.
Spectator Parking	Parking is <u>free</u> , but spectators will pay the <u>\$6/person (or \$10/car) admission fee</u> prior to parking. There is plenty of parking available from the high school entrance on Silver Lake Road and the middle school entrance on Lobdell Road.
Dogs/Pets	Please begin to inform parents/fans that only service dogs properly adorned will be allowed around the course. We have had coaches and runners indicate they have had bad experiences on courses with dogs. This event is for our student athletes and they should not have to worry about a dog. Please assist us in making this the best opportunity for our kids to be successful by asking spectators to leave their dogs at home.
Concessions	Light snacks and beverages will be available for purchase.
T-Shirts	Souvenir t-shirts will be available for purchase.
Restrooms	Port-a-potties will be available for all athletes and spectators. The stadium restrooms will also be open for athletes and spectators. The school restroom facilities will be available only to those spectators with a disability.

*A fourth team may qualify if they have 4 finishers in the top 20 and finish 4th in the region.

Drone Use	<p>MHSAA UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLE (DRONE) POLICY The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (“UAV”), also known as drones, is prohibited for any purpose by any persons at MHSAA tournament venues. Tournament management shall refuse admission or entry to anyone attempting to use a UAV; and if necessary, tournament management shall remove anyone attempting to use a UAV and/or confiscate the UAV until the event has been completed.</p>
Privacy Policy	<p>Per MHSAA policy using devices of any kind to capture or transmit images is strictly prohibited in locker rooms, dressing areas, training rooms, weigh-in rooms, showers, restrooms, or other areas where there is an expectation of privacy during MHSAA tournament events. Tournament managers or athletic directors that discover such use should move immediately to have the device removed and inform the head coach or athletic director of the identity and nature of the activity of the person involved.</p>
