Dear Coaches/Singles Qualifiers:

Congratulations on advancing to the 2022 MHSAA LP Girls Tennis Finals. Here is a list of things you will need to know prior to arriving for this year's event:

- We will be using two sites, Hope College Tennis Center and Holland Christian High School, for the first day of the tournament.
 - o If you did not have two coaches listed on your regional coaches' form, please e-mail the names of both of your coaches to rosemic191@gmail.com and indicate which one is your head coach. This is mandatory for the creation of coaching badges that each of the coaches will need. For day two only, one site will be used and two coaches will be allowed per team. Please make sure that any coach that will be utilized has completed the necessary MHSAA rules meeting.
- Coaches of teams/individual qualifiers may pick up their tournament packet between 7:00 am and 7:30 am at the Hope College Tennis Center on Friday, June 3rd.
- Mandatory coach and player meeting is scheduled at 7:30 am on Friday, June 3rd at the Hope College Tennis Center (weather permitting).
 - Important information about the tournament will be given out at this time. All
 players should attend this meeting before going to their sites.
- Play will begin on Friday, June 3rd at the Hope College Tennis Center at 8:00 am and at Holland Christian High School at 8:30 am. Saturday matches will start at 8:00 am.
- The school buildings will be off limits to all. Please do not try to access the building at either site.
- MHSAA rules regarding team uniforms will be enforced throughout the tournament.
- Point penalty system will be enforced. Keep in mind that code violations from the Regional Tournament carry over into the State Tournament.
