



MHSAA SEEKS CANDIDATES FOR ASSISTANT DIRECTOR

EAST LANSING, MI – NOVEMBER 30, 2015 . . . The July 2016 retirement of Assistant Director Gina Mazzolini causes the Michigan High School Athletic Association to invite candidates for an administrative level employment position at the MHSAA's East Lansing headquarters.

Candidates must be able to demonstrate deep respect for the educational philosophy of school-sponsored sports and the positive contributions they make to students, schools and society. While warm interpersonal relationships and the ability to communicate effectively in writing and speaking are essential and more necessary than any specific sport or subject background, the MHSAA will be addressing the following responsibilities during this hiring and/or the reorganization of duties of existing staff:

Administration of Sports –

Primary: Swimming & Diving, Tennis, Girls Volleyball

Secondary: Alpine Skiing, Basketball, Girls Competitive Cheer, Track & Field, Football, Girls Gymnastics, Wrestling

Other Administrative Responsibilities or Assistance –

Primary: Health & Safety, International Students, Interstate Sanctioning

Secondary: Officials' Services, Coaches' Education, Student Leadership

The MHSAA will provide a salary and benefits package comparable with those of full-time school administrators in Michigan. It is expected that the assistant director will work many evenings and weekends and will reside in mid-Michigan.
