MHSAA Tournament Rules will apply. Two (2) balls allowed in the bowling area with one ball allowed on the ball return for the five (5) bowlers at a time. All other bowling balls and bags are to be in the team's reserved ball section.

Cost

There is a \$2.50 per lane per bowler fee for each school. If you are competing in both the Singles (maximum 6) and Team, the cost per team will be \$90.00 for Singles and \$52.50 for Team. For a school with a boys and girls team, the cost is \$285.00 (\$142.50 per team). ***Please make the check payable to Spare Time Lanes.*** The entry fee is due prior to the first day of the tournament. You may bring the check with you or mail it to Cheboygan Athletics c/o Lisa Gibbons, 801 W. Admission

There will be a \$6.00 admission for spectators each day. Similar to all MHSAA Tournaments, administrators are asked to sign in and will enter without charge. **Please** inform your parents and spectators of this admission charge to avoid problems at the tournament.

Format

The **Friday Team** competition will consist of three (3) alternating lane Baker sets and three (3) 5-man team games. After each Baker set and each team game, teams on odd lanes will move right one pair and teams on the even lanes will move right two pair. During **Saturday's Single** competition each bowler will bowl a six game block moving one pair right after each game. Total pin count will determine the top ten (10) singles and the top three (3) teams who move on to the State Finals, which is being held at Jax 60 in Jackson on Friday, March 6 and Saturday, March 7. **Tie breaker in Singles will** be one regular game, if still tied then a 9-10th frame roll-off repeated until the tie is broken. **Tie breaker in Team** will be one Baker set (2 games), if still tied then a 6-10th frame Baker format roll-off repeated until tie is broken. Tie breaker pins will not count for total, only to break the tie.

Oil Pattern

Kegel "Allen" oil pattern will be used.

Practice Time

There will be ten (10) minutes of practice prior to the start of the Singles tournament and fifteen (15) minutes for Team (7 ½ minutes on each lane).

Lane Assignments

Jason Friday, Cheboygan Athletic Director, will make the lane assignments by random draw prior to the tournament. Lane assignments will be posted at the doors and at the coaches meeting.

Practice prior to the tournament

Teams may contact **Spare Time Lanes** for practice times for open bowling. No practice is available on tournament days. A coach must monitor any practice.

Dress Code

Boys – Slacks are required. Jeans, cutoffs, shorts, sweatpants or warm-up pants will NOT be allowed. A collared shirt or a mock turtleneck shirt will be required. Absolutely, NO T-shirts will be allowed.

Girls – Slacks, shorts or skirts will be allowed. Skirts must reach the top of the knee and shorts shall be an appropriate length (no daisy dukes or holes). Jeans, cutoffs, sweatpants, warm-ups, **yoga/spandex pants will NOT be allowed**. A collared shirt or a mock turtleneck shirt will be required. Absolutely, NO T-shirts will be allowed.

Both – Neither boys or girls may wear hats, caps, or any other type of head gear. All cell phones, I-pods, CD players, MP3 players, DVD players, etc. may not be used by any competitor on the concourse during competition. Prior to competition, warm ups (jackets, sweatshirts, hoodies) must be removed and may not be used in competition.

If a violation of the MHSAA bowling dress code occurs, a warning will be given to the player and coach of the violating team. If at that time the dress code is not followed, a loss of bowling privileges and disqualification from the MHSAA Regionals or Finals will result. Coaches must also adhere to the MHSAA dress code regulations.

Coaching Restrictions

Two school coaches will be allowed in the bowlers' seating area during competition. Coaches are not allowed on the approaches. Coaching is allowed ONLY between frames. Coaches may NOT use IPADS for coaching in the bowlers' area.

Substitutions

A standard starting lineup for team competition will consist of 5 bowlers. Line-ups may change in subsequent games. Starting bowlers must bowl at least one frame before being substituted for. Once a substitute enters the game, he/she must finish that game. Substitutions in mid-frame are allowed. The bowler who is substituted for may return as a starter or substitute in subsequent games. The substitute must be on the eight person roster at the start of competition. All five starting bowlers may be substituted for in any given game. If a substitute is injured, they may be replaced by an eligible substitute.

Sportsmanship

Good sportsmanship for players and coaches is a must. Taunting, profanity, and intimidating conduct are not allowed. All MHSAA regulations regarding sportsmanship and disqualification penalties as stated in Regulation IV, Section 3 will be followed. Players will not be allowed on the approach to congratulate or celebrate the accomplishment of a fellow team member during bowling. Bowlers will not be allowed to enter an adjacent lane approach to celebrate or 'run-out' their delivery. Bowlers shall observe a one-lane courtesy for bowlers on adjacent lanes.

Alcohol and Tobacco

No alcohol or tobacco is allowed in the bowling area during any MHSAA event.
