MHSAA Tournament Rules will apply. Limit of two (2) balls in the bowling area with one ball allowed on the ball return for the five (5) bowlers at a time. All other bowling balls and bags are to be in the paddock area.

Cost

There is a \$2.50 per line per bowler fee for each school. If you are competing in both the Singles (max. 6) and Team (max. 7), the cost per team will be \$ 90.00 for singles and \$ 52.50 for Team. For a school with a Boys and Girls team, the cost is \$ 285.00 (\$142.50 per team).

Please make checks payable to Richfield Bowl. The entry fee is due prior to or on the first day of the tournament. You may bring the check with you or mail it to **Richfield Bowl, 5340 Richfield Rd, Flint MI 48506.**

Admission

There will be a \$6.00 admission fee for spectators. Similar to all MHSAA Tournaments, administrators are asked to sign in and will enter without charge. Please inform your parents and spectators of this admission charge to avoid problems at the tournament. No passes will be accepted. PLEASE CARPOOL, AS PARKING IS LIMITED. B's Bowling or Richfield Bowl will not allow outside beverage or food brought into the center.

Format

The **Friday Team Competition** will consist of three (3) alternating lane Baker Sets and three (3) five man team games. After each Baker set and each team game, teams on odd lanes will move right, skipping one pair and teams on the even lanes will move right skipping two pair. During **Saturday's Single Competition**, each bowler will bowl a six game block. Bowlers will move right one pair after each game. Total pin count will determine the top ten (10) singles and the top three (3) teams who move on to the State Finals, which is being held at **Royal Scot, Lansing on March 6th and 7th**. Tiebreaker in **Singles** will be a one (1) game roll-off, if still tied, a 9-10th frame roll-off repeated until the tie is broken. Tie breaker in team will be one set (2) games of Baker, if still tied then a 6-10th frame Baker format roll-off repeated until tie is broken. Tie breaker pins will not count toward the total, just to break the tie.

Practice Time

There will be fifteen (15) minutes of warm-up (7 ½ minutes on each lane) prior to start on Friday for Team and Singles on Saturday.

Lane Assignments

Lane assignments will be made by random draw prior to the tournament. Lane assignments will be posted at the doors and at the coaches meeting.

Practice Prior to the Tournament

Teams may contact **B's Bowling** or **Richfield Bowl** for practice times for open bowling. No practice is available on tournament days. A coach must be present and monitor any practice.

Dress Code

Boys: Slacks are required. Jeans, cutoffs, shorts, sweat pants or warm-up pants will NOT be allowed. A collared shirt or a mock neck bowling shirt will be required. Absolutely NO t-shirts will be allowed.

Girls: Slacks, shorts or skirts will be allowed. Skirts must reach the top of the knee and shorts shall be an appropriate length (no daisy dukes or holes). Jeans, cutoffs, sweat pants, warm-ups, or yoga pants will NOT be allowed. A collared shirt or mock neck bowling shirt will be required. Absolutely NO t-shirts will be allowed. Neither boys nor girls may wear hats, caps, or any other type of head gear.

Both: All cell phones, iPods, CD players, MP3 players, DVD players, etc. may not be used by any competitor on the concourse during competition.

Coaching Restrictions

Two school coaches will be allowed in the bowlers seating area during competition. Coaches are not allowed on the approaches. Coaching is allowed ONLY between frames. Coaches must follow dress code.

Substitutions

A standard starting lineup for team competition will consist of 5 bowlers. Lineups may change in subsequent games. Starting bowlers must bowl at least one frame before substituted for. Once a substitute enters the game, he/she must finish that game. Substitutions in mid-frame are allowed. The bowler who is substituted for may return as a starter or substitute in a subsequent game. The substitute must be on the eight person roster at the start of competition. All five starting bowlers may be substituted for in any given game. If a substitute is injured, they may be replaced by an eligible substitute.

Sportsmanship

Good sportsmanship for players and coaches is a must. Taunting, profanity, and intimidating conduct are not allowed. All MHSAA regulations regarding sportsmanship and disqualification penalties as stated in Regulations IV, section 3, will be followed. Players will not be allowed on the approach to congratulate or celebrate the accomplishment of a fellow team member during bowling. Bowlers will not be allowed to enter an adjacent lane approach to celebrate or "run-out" their delivery. Bowlers shall observe a one-lane courtesy for bowlers on adjacent lanes.

Alcohol and Tobacco

No alcohol or tobacco is allowed during any MHSAA event.
