After the dive order is established, no other divers will be allowed in the meet.

#### **Diving Entry-Qualification Meet**

- I. Each coach must enter via <u>cleanentries.com</u> by the deadline of NOVEMBER 9, 2021, a list of divers who have qualified for the Qualification Meet and the 11 dives. In addition, any changes to the completed diving sheet for each qualified diver must be presented to the Qualification Meet Manager no later than 1 ½ hours prior to the meet. The diving sheet provided at the site must contain the signature of the contestant and coach. The coach verifies the qualification and proper order of dives. The contestant's signature indicates that the list of dives is correct. Please include individual score of dual meets for six dives or scores for 11 dives in a league, conference or invitational meet.
- II. A diver will not be allowed to participate if the Diving Entry List is not completed properly. The diver must be accompanied by the school coach or designated school representative (so indicated by letter signed by the Principal).

Once the dive order is established, no other divers will be allowed in the meet.

- III. Diving Warm-Up for Qualification Meet Warm-up diving at Qualification Meets will not be permitted until two hours prior to the meet. No one, including the host school's divers or any diver coached by the host school's coach, may use the Regional facility within one hour of the scheduled warm-up.
- IV. Finas Meet Method of Selection Diving.
  - a. Based upon the number of entries present, each MHSAA Regional Diving Qualification Meet will advance a specific number of qualifiers to the Final Meet (resulting in 36 divers at each Final Meet).
  - b. The number of divers advancing to the Final Meet will be based on the percentage of the total entry for the Division at each Qualification Meet. The number of divers advancing and the cuts for each Qualification Meet are set before the data is sent to the Qualification Meet hosts and cannot be changed by the host site. Entries must be received by Noon on November 9. Deck entries are not permitted at Diving Qualification Meets.
  - c. Cuts will be determined based upon the number of entries at each Qualification Meet. Specific cut protocols will be sent to Diving

Qualification Meet Managers prior to November 11 and posted to MHSAA.com. All those entered should be prepared to perform an 11-dive list.

#### **COVID GUIDELINES:**

- Masks, covering the nose and mouth will be required for all coaches and participants at all times, except for when a diver is on the board to perform a dive.
- Athletes will be expected to socially distance from other divers by at least 6 feet around the pool deck and/or in the stands
